No. 30: Thompson Street Capital Partners

2007 revenue: \$590 million

Thompson Street Capital Partners had a busy year with acquisitions and divestitures. Founded in 2001 by Jim Cooper and Peter Finley, its managing principals, Thompson Street sold its majority stake in Kele Inc., a heating and cooling components supplier. It was Thompson Street's biggest divestiture to date. In November, the firm made an equity investment and helped Iron Data Solutions acquire I. Levy and Associates Inc., a Chesterfield developer of Social Security benefits management software. In October, Thompson Street acquired a majority interest in DCL Medical Laboratories Inc., an Indianapolis health-care firm.
